Yoon wins endorsement from Greater Boston Labor Council

The Greater Boston Labor Council, a coalition of 140 local unions and district councils, endorsed At-Large City Councilor Sam Yoon in his first bid for reelection since winning a seat on the Council in 2005.

“I am tremendously proud and honored to receive this endorsement from the Labor Council,” Yoon said in a press release. “The working men and women of Boston provide such a valuable service, not only during their work lives, but contributing to the strength and vitality of each of Boston’s communities.”

In addition to the GBLC endorsement, Yoon has received the support of eight local unions thus far: the Boston Carmen’s Union Local 589, International Painters and Allied Trades (IUPAT) Local #25, Sheetmetal Workers Local 17, the United Food and Commercial Workers (UFCW) Local 1455, the Utility Workers of America (UWA) Local #389, the International Union of Operating Engineers (IUOE) Local #4, the Boston Teachers Union (BTU), and the Gay and Lesbian Labor Action Network (GALLAN-PAW).
